### **PROGRAM OVERVIEW:**

United Airlines is partnering with the Office of Children's Affairs with the City and County of Denver to provide professional learning opportunities in the field of aviation. Selected interns will be part of a mentorship program that will include training to provide general customer assistance throughout the airport. This is an **8-week program** in which interns will work **40 hours a week**, and receive payment for their services at **\$11.20/hour**.

### **TO BE CONSIDERED FOR AN INTERVIEW, APPLICANTS MUST BE:**

- Age 18 - 26 years old at the time of application and reside in the City and County of Denver (proof may be required)
- Graduating high school (or GED) in 2018, or enrolled/attending college
- Able to provide an original social security card (no copies), a government-issued ID and a birth certificate at the interview
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S. for any employer without sponsorship or future sponsorship

### **APPLICANTS SHOULD HAVE THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Ability to handle simultaneous situations and adapt to a fast-paced, changing environment
- Solid interpersonal skills with a focus on teamwork
- Strong verbal communication skills
- Ability to adhere to United's appearance guidelines (review guidelines linked below)
- Flexibility and willingness to work any shift, including early mornings, nights, weekends and holidays
